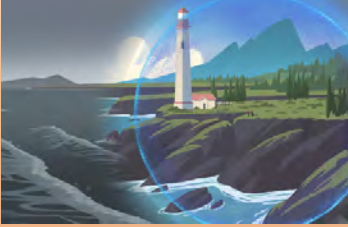

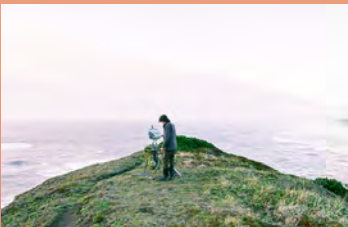
## I'm a Child
